**BACKGROUND:** The majority of the American Indian Veterans Association (AIVA) members are veterans from southern California Indian Tribes. The primary commitment of the (AVIA) is to provide help to other veterans in need. More superficially the organization provides its services within the southern California Tribal areas.

**CURRENT FUNDRAISER:** The (AVIA) has scheduled a charity scramble golf tournament at the **Soboba Springs Country Club on August 1, 2015**. The American Indian Veterans Association has partnered with *Krank-it-Hole* to provide the tournament management and the Southern California American Indian Resource Center, Inc., (SCAIR) to provide the fiscal management for the project. *Krank-It-Hole* is a nationwide charity golf tournament management company that is affiliated with Krank Golf the manufacture of world class golf clubs. *Krank-It-Hole* and SCAIR do not charge any fees for their services.

**PURPOSE OF EVENT:** The primary purpose of the American Indian Veterans Association fundraiser is to raise funds with which to continue providing services and assistance to other veterans in need. In way of example many American Indian Veterans are in need of transportation to the VA hospital. Still other may need assistance with finding housing or other primary needs.
