This was a life changing event, but we look at the positive, I am alive. After 4 months of rehab and surgeries, I am not home yet but I hope to be home soon. I will have some perment disability, but I will be back to work for Indian country soon. This terrible accident reminds me there is much more work to do for our Tribal members and I want to be a part of it.
